Police Investigating Hit and Run/Burglary/Theft

In the evening hours of 7/28/2016, officers from the Sheboygan Police Department responded to calls of a hit and run of an unattended vehicle and someone attempting to steal from an unlocked car in a south side neighborhood. Officers arriving on scene located the suspect vehicle and attempted to make a traffic stop. The operator of the vehicle fled from the officer. The officer did not pursue but noticed the car pull into a nearby driveway. Two men who were in the car fled on foot. Officers surrounded the area and noticed a man flee on a bicycle from a nearby garage. It was later found that one of the suspects burglarized an unlocked garage and stole a bicycle.

The suspects were identified and a search warrant was obtained for a north side home. The stolen bicycle was located and one of the suspects was taken into custody. A short time later the second man turned himself in to the police department.

A 22 year old Sheboygan man was referred to the Sheboygan County District Attorney's Office for the following charges: Eluding an Officer, Burglary, Disorderly Conduct, Obstructing, Operating after Revocation, and Possession of Schedule II Non-Narcotic Drugs.

A 17 year old Sheboygan man was referred to the Sheboygan County District Attorney's Office for Obstructing.
