Taught by Sheboygan Police Officers Hang Lor and Dana Fischer, and directed at middle school students, the Junior Police Academy is a mini police academy for young people. During the program, students will participate in several hands-on lessons taught by Officer Lor and other Police Officers, including police operations, traffic stops, defense and arrest tactics, handcuffing, scenario resolutions, crime scene investigations (evidence collection, fingerprinting, crime scene reconstruction), and an overview of the court system (including a mock trial). Students will also hear presentations from representatives of specialized units such as the Drug Unit, Dive Team, K9, and SWAT.

The five-day program is currently scheduled to run the week of Monday, June 26th through Friday, June 30th from 8:30AM-12:30PM at the Sheboygan Police Department.

Cadets will receive a JPA t-shirt, Cadet Handbook, and other JPA accessories. Successful graduates will be able to attend a graduation ceremony where they will receive their JPA Graduation Certificate. Our expectation is that graduates of the program will someday become the community leaders of tomorrow - instilled with an appreciation and respect for law enforcers and their role in society. The goal of the program is simple - to build meaningful partnerships with students, motivating them to be responsible, involved citizens.

Class size is limited, so if you would like your child to be considered for the Academy, please complete the information below as soon as possible. Students selected for the Academy will be **notified via email** prior to June 20th and will receive additional information at that time. Cadets will be operating in a live, working police department under close supervision from their instructors (at no time will cadets have access to live or lethal equipment).

Severe safety violations will result in immediate removal and possible legal consequences. We want you to have fun and learn but also feel safe while doing so!
