**On 12/31/17, Sheboygan Police responded to a residence in the 1500 block of Martin Avenue, in Sheboygan, in response to shots fired into a residence. Sheboygan Police have since identified a suspect in the incident and are currently attempting to locate him. The suspect is identified as, Deontre Tremaine Smith, age 23. Deontre is further described as a male black, 5'11 and weighing 160 pounds. He has short black hair and has a tattoo of a cross between his eyes. Deontre is also known as "Chop". **Original release from 12/31below:**

**On 12/31/17, at approximately 3:22AM, Sheboygan Police responded to a residence in the 1500 block of Martin Avenue in response to a report of shots fired into the residence. Responding officers arrived and found the residence was empty. The investigation has since revealed that a resident and several acquaintances were present inside the residence when the shots were fired from a passing vehicle on Martin Avenue. The occupants then left prior to police arriving on scene. Nobody was injured during the incident. Police are attempting to locate additional witnesses along with a person of interest in connection with the case. This incident was not a random act, as the people involved are known to each other. The investigation is ongoing, anyone with information about this incident is asked to call Sheboygan Police at 920-459-3333.**
