During the program, students will participate in several hands-on lessons taught by Sheboygan Police Officers, including police operations, traffic stops, defense and arrest tactics, handcuffing, scenario resolutions, crime scene investigations (evidence collection, fingerprinting, crime scene reconstruction) and more! Students will also hear presentations from representatives of specialized units such as the Drug Unit, K9, and SWAT and more!

The five-day program is currently scheduled to run the week of Monday, July 16<sup>th</sup> through Friday, July 20<sup>th</sup> from 8:30 AM-12:30 PM, at the Sheboygan Police Department.

Cadets will receive a JPA t-shirt and a Cadet Handbook. Successful graduates will be able to attend a graduation ceremony where they will receive their JPA Graduation Certificate. Our expectation is that graduates of the program will someday become the community leaders of tomorrow - instilled with an appreciation and respect for law enforcers and their role in society. The goal of the program is simple - to build meaningful partnerships with students, motivating them to be responsible, involved citizens.

Due to the continued interest in this program we have added some criteria when reviewing applications. One of those being SASD students will be given priority over non-SASD students. Class size is limited, so if you would like your child to be considered for the Academy, please complete the information below as soon as possible.
