1). SEND AN EMAIL & TEXT MESSAGE TO CONFIRM THE RECEIPT OF YOUR PACKET AS SOON AS YOU RECEIVE THIS MEMO (longrimes00788@gmail.com) (205) 941-7712

2). Please go to your bank and have the check deposited, this helps to confirm the right recipient has the check. (\$1950.60)

C (EMAIL OR TEXT ME IMMEDIATELY AFTER THE DEPOSIT HAS BEEN MADE FOR THE FUNDS TO BE MADE AVAILABLE TO YOU) (longrimes00788@gmail.com) (205) 941-7712

3). The funds would be available in a few hours or the next business day. Once funds are available, withdraw the cash and deduct your commission which is \$400, and extra \$50 to cover the cost of your run around expenses, However the rest of the funds would be paid to the Graphic artist that will install the decal on your vehicle. B – Recipient did not sign-up for offer

C – Should not have to email/text to gain access to legitimate funds; Gmail addresses are easy to fake

D – Details of offer are concealed until recipient cashes the check

E – Entire paragraph is confusing and does not seem legitimate; promises “subsequent payments”

F – Warning implying that money may be lost if directions aren’t followed exactly
