Lateral Transfer Credit

New hires can receive up to 5 years of credit for prior police experience for both pay and vacation steps, depending on experience.

WI Retirement Fund:

City pays 14.3% of employee's annual income Employee pays 6.9% of annual income

Health Insurance:

High deductible single, employee/spouse, employee/children and family plans are available. Employee pays 8.7% of premium payments. HSA savings plans are available through the employer. City has made \$750 individual and \$1,500 family contributions to employee HSAs since 2015.

Dental Insurance:

City pays 85% of single or family premium. Employee pays 15%

Uniform Allowance:

\$800.00 Initial Allowance \$1,000.00 Initial Body Armor reimbursement \$720.00 Minimum every year thereafter \$100.00 annually for special assignments \$200.00 annually for body armor replacement

Life Insurance:

City pays 100% of the cost of the Wisconsin Employee Group plan for the basic unit of coverage.

Holidays:

10 days of compensatory pay in lieu of holidays. Extra pay on holidays worked.

Vacation:

101 hours after 1 - 4 years of service. 144 hours after 5 - 9 years of service. 170 hours after 10-14 years of service. 229 hours after 15 years of service.

Sick Leave:

Earn 1 day for each completed month of service, up to 144 days. More than 144 days are pooled.
